artwork has been exhibited throughout California, and is in collections across the nation. Maynard is also a consultant in nonprofit management and program development, and serves on many community boards.




Anna Oneglia is a painter and printmaker in Arcata. She's a believer in Open Studios, because there's nothing like seeing where and how things are made.




